Project: WUTHERING HEIGHTS BY EMILY BRONTE

If Wuthering heights could be packed into a box, what memories would survive

The Lost Trunk from Thrushcross Grange

Project Concept: Imagine that after many years, an old wooden trunk is discovered in the attic of Thrushcross Grange. Inside are personal belongings, secret letters, weathered objects, and emotional fragments from the world of Wuthering Heights.

Your task is to create this literary memory trunk as a hands-on 3D project.

What Students have to do:

Create a "Memory Trunk" (shoebox/cardboard box) containing at least 5 artefacts from the novel.

These objects should represent characters, relationships, conflicts, or key events.

YOUR TASK:
Create a "Memory Trunk" filled with meaningful artifacts from the novel Wuthering Heights. Each item should represent a character, event or theme.

WUTHERING HEIGHTS

The Lost Trunk from Thrushcross Grange

PROJECT REFERENCE TEMPLATE

EXAMPLE ARTIFACT IDEAS

WHAT TO INCLUDE:

1. At least 8 artifacts (objects, letters, sketches, notes, etc.)
2. A tag for each item (What is it? Who does it belong to? What does it symbolize?)
3. One secret letter (A letter that was never shown in the novel)
4. Creative decoration (Make your trunk look old, vintage and connected to the moors!)

EXAMPLE TAG

What is it?
A dried flower
Who does it belong to?
Catherine Earnshaw
What does it symbolize?
Her wild, passionate and free spirit, linked to the moors.

Students can design and label items such as:

A diary page with her thoughts about Heathcliff and Edgar
A dried flower from the moors
A torn ribbon

FOR HEATHCLIFF:

A revenge map or property deed
A lock of hair
A storm sketch
A fake letter to Catherine

FOR HINDLEY:

Gambling receipts or debt notes

FOR THRUSHCROSS GRANGE:

Elegant invitation card
Mini portrait sketch

SYMBOLIC OBJECTS:

Window fragment
Key
Feather
Mini weather chart

Presentation Element: Students could decorate the trunk/box in Gothic style using dark colours, Misty moor aesthetic, Victorian design or lock and key representation.

Please Note: Each artifact must include a small handwritten tag answering:

1. What is this object?
2. Which character does it belong to?
3. How does it symbolize an important theme (love, revenge, social class, isolation)?
(Use about 50 words to explain this theme)

The speaking assessment will be conducted simultaneously when the students present their respective Memory Trunks.

Shark Tank Mathematics Challenge

- * investment

Sales Data Challenge

Record imaginary weekly sales and create:

- bar graph
- pie chart
- comparison chart

Explain using mathematical data and calculations.

Choose **ONE** disaster and explain:

- Causes
- Effects on people & environment
- Real-life example (floods in Punjab last year)



3 SAFETY & PREPAREDNESS (MOST IMPORTANT)

Explain clearly:

- ✓ What should people do before, during, and after the disaster
- ✓ Emergency kit (water, torch, first aid, documents)
- ✓ Safety tips (Drop–Cover–Hold, evacuation, etc.)

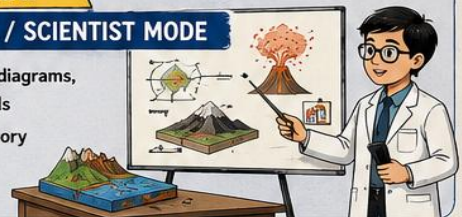

- Maximum: 3 minutes

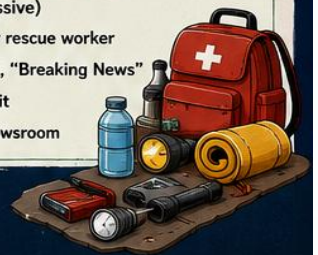

- Click "Create Blog".



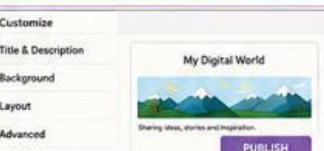
4 CHOOSE A THEME (TEMPLATE)

6 CREATE PAGES

- Create essential pages:

- Click "Publish".



7 WRITE AND PUBLISH BLOG POSTS

- Click on "New Post".

8 ADD WIDGETS & FEATURES

- Go to "Layout".
- Add useful widgets like:
